Promotion to Grade One & School Fees Update

All children who were commissioned from Kindergarten will automatically be admitted to Primary One, and their school fees remain unchanged. All existing pupils will also maintain the same fees structure, **except** those progressing to Grade 5 (Primary Five).

Parents are encouraged to start depositing school fees early on the school payment number so that **at least 80%** of the fees is cleared before Term 1 begins. Early deposits help the school prepare effectively and ensure a smooth opening of the new academic year.
